






The Ontario Hockey Association (OHA), founded in 1890, is the governing body for the majority of Junior and Senior hockey in the Province of Ontario.

The OHA is comprised of three Junior hockey leagues and one Senior hockey league: Junior A - Ontario Junior Hockey League (OJHL); Junior B - Greater Ontario Junior Hockey League (GOJHL); Junior C - Provincial Junior Hockey League (PJHL); and Sr. AAA - Allan Cup Hockey (ACH). During the 2021-2022 season, these four leagues will encompass a total of 109 teams. The majority of the players are 16-21 years of age.

A total of 115 OHA graduates played in the NHL during the 2020-2021 season.

These four leagues encompassed 115 teams at the Junior and Senior levels within its jurisdictional borders in Ontario and two teams in the state of New York.

OHA MEMORIAL CUP

The OHA decided in its December 1918 meeting to establish a memorial to commemorate the fallen players. The result was the OHA Memorial Cup, which would be for Canada-wide competition among junior teams. The first championship was won by the University of Toronto Schools in 1919.


